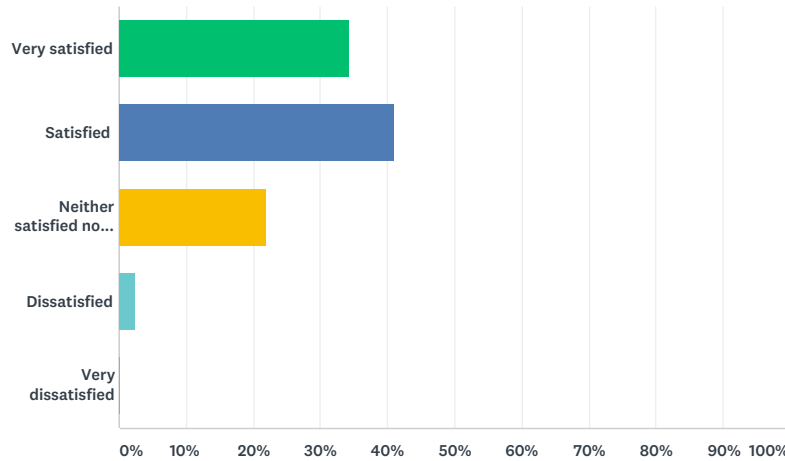

Q5 In the coming year, how likely are you to volunteer to be part of the community association executive, to join a committee, and/or to help plan/run a community event?

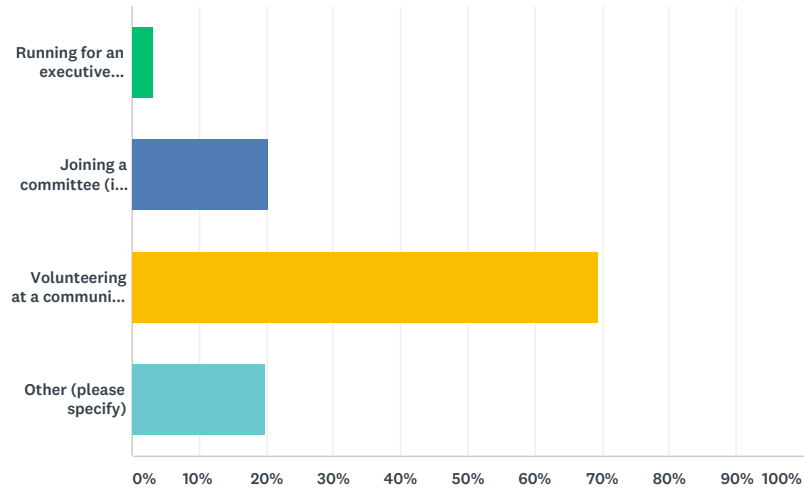

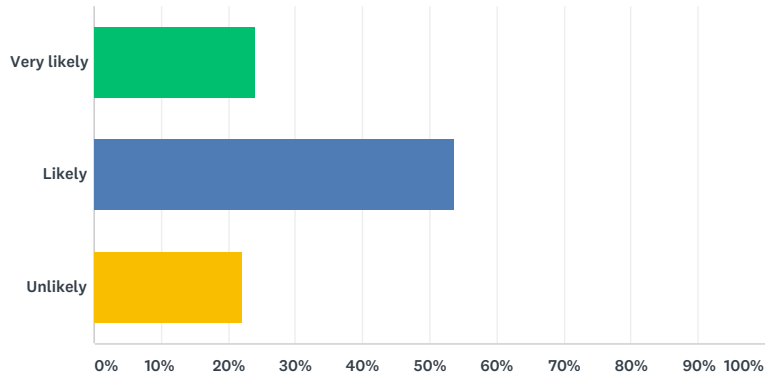

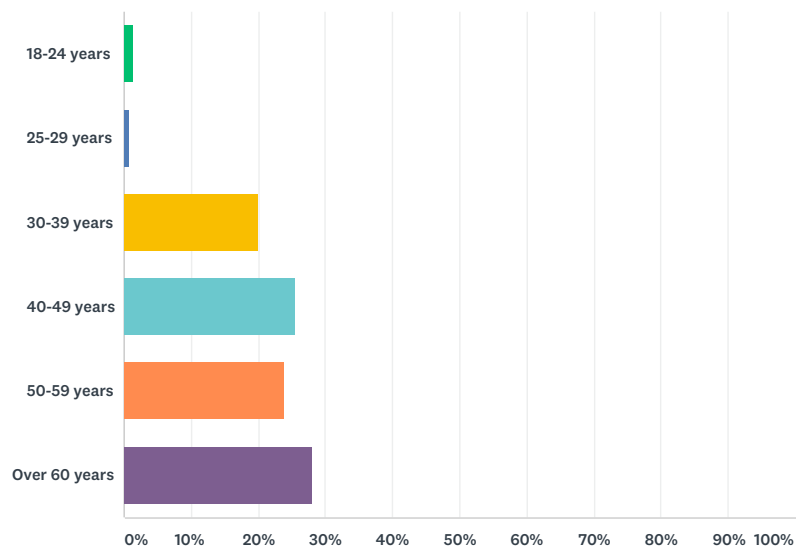
