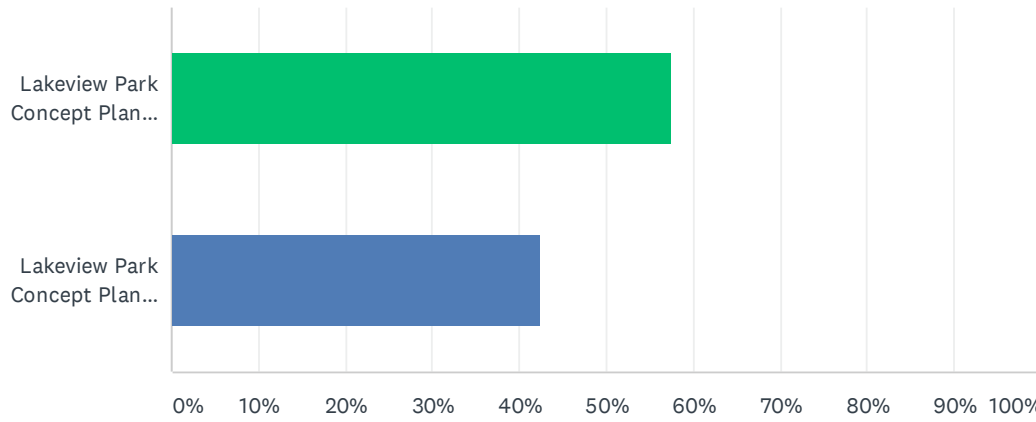


Q1 Please indicate which of the concept plan below you prefer
